

Located on the scenic San Juan Skyway in the heart of southwest Colorado's San Juan Mountains, Telluride and Mountain Village are 67 miles south of Montrose, 127 miles south of Grand Junction, 125 miles northwest of Durango, 7 hours from Denver, 8 from Phoenix and 6 from Albuquerque.

Mountain Village is connected to Telluride by a free gondola ride. Located at 9,500 feet above sea level, Mountain Village overlooks some of Colorado's most magnificent peaks. The year round alpine resort was founded in 1987 and hosts the ski resort headquarters, a golf course, restaurants, lodging, shops and other amenities of a thriving community.


